

**Pursuant** to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the **Act**), Bellberry Distillery Limited (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 27 Gilmore Road RD 10 Hamilton 3290 and known as BELLBERRY DISTILLERY LIMITED, to any person for consumption off the premises.

**Endorsement**

Section 40 of the Act applies to this licence; and the licensee is authorised to sell alcohol from (but not on) the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

**Conditions**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) Alcohol may be sold at any time, on any day, while always trading as a remote seller.
- (b) Alcohol must not be delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day, or between 11:00pm and 6:00am the following day.
- (c) Alcohol sales are limited to only those manufactured by Bellberry Distillery Limited.
- (d) The licensed premises is described in the plan date stamped as received by the Waipa District Licensing Committee on 20 June 2023.
- (e) The licensee must take reasonable steps to verify that the buyer and the receiver of an alcohol delivery is not under 18 years of age, and that the receiver (where present) is not intoxicated.
- (f) The outside of the delivery package must contain a label with the following words:


**CONTAINS ALCOHOL**

- Do not leave at destination without proof of delivery.
  - Do not deliver to intoxicated persons or persons under 18 years of age.
- (g) A copy of the licence must be displayed on the Bellberry Distillery Limited internet site in a prominent place.
  - (h) Every receipt for the sale of alcohol by remote sale must contain the licence holder's name, licence number and the date on which the licence expires.

**Duration**

- i) Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force **until the expiry date shown at the bottom of this licence.**
- ii) If an application for the renewal of the licence is made in accordance with the Act before the licence expires, the licence will remain in force until that renewal application is determined (provided it is determined before the next anniversary of the licence). **(BUT NO LATER THAN THREE YEARS FROM ITS EXPIRY)**
- iii) If the licence is renewed, a replacement licence will be issued with an amended expiry date.
- iv) This licence automatically expires if a licence of the same type is issued in respect to the same licensed premises (i.e. to a new operator).
